(h) I did not buy a lottery ticket this week or I bought a lottery ticket this week and won the million dollar jackpot on Friday. (1pt)

(b) You pass the course if and only if you do not miss the final examination. (1pt)
(c) If you miss the final examination, then you do not pass the course. (1pt)
(d) You have the flu, or miss the final examination, or pass the course. (1pt)
(e) If you have the flu, then you do not pass the course, or if you miss the final examination, then you do not pass the course. (Alternatively: If you have the flu or miss the final examination, you do not pass the course.) (1pt)
(f) You have the flu and miss the final examination, or you do not miss the final examination and pass the course. (1pt)
