

Contingency information regarding H1N1

I hope everyone is, and remains, in the best of health. Nonetheless, it is prudent to plan, and the following information should be part of that plan:

- You may wish to identify another student *at the start of term* who can take notes for you
- You are responsible for all the work in the class, even if you miss because of illness. All reasonable efforts, however, will be made to accommodate absence due to illness.
- Students will not have notes from the University Health Service (UHS) for flu. The UHS has announced that they will not have the capacity to generate notes for students with flu. Remember:
 - It is a violation of the honor code to claim to be sick when you are not, but
 - If you are sick, email me and your academic advisor and stay home, and to do so as soon as possible (rather than simply disappearing for a week and only then telling me you were sick, after the fact).
- Be sure to check with the appropriate advisors if you think you must drop the class (dropping classes can have many unexpected effects and costs, and is not an automatic)
