American Association of University Woman Graduate Fellowships (AAUW)

- American Fellowships support women doctoral candidates completing dissertations or scholars seeking funds for postdoctoral research leave from accredited institutions.
- Applicants must be US Citizens or permanent residents.
- Candidates are evaluated on the basis of scholarly excellence, teaching experience, and active commitment to helping women and girls through service in their communities, professions or fields of research.
- International Fellowships are awarded to full-time study or research to women who are not U.S Citizens or permanent residents. Both graduate and postgraduate study at accredited institutions are supported.

Jack Kent Cooke Foundation Graduate Scholarship Program

You must meet the following minimum eligibility requirements to be considered for nomination by your college or university for the Jack Kent Cooke Foundation Graduate Scholarship Program:

- Be a senior or a recent graduate (since spring 2003) of an accredited US college or university.
- Have a bachelor's degree by the start of the fall semester.
- Have a cumulative undergraduate grade point average of 3.50 or better on a 4.0 scale (or the equivalent).
- Be nominated by his or her undergraduate institution.
- Have unmet financial need.
- Not previously have been nominated for the Jack Kent Cooke Foundation graduate scholarship.
- Plan to begin a full-time graduate or professional degree program at an accredited university in Fall 2009. This must be the first graduate degree the candidate has ever pursued.

If you meet all of the above criteria, please review the Nominee Guidelines - Graduate Scholarship Program for more information, including selection criteria. If you also meet those selection criteria, contact the designated faculty representative for your college or university to learn more about the institutional process, including further eligibility requirements. Each institution may nominate up to two students or recent graduates every year to compete for the graduate scholarship.

- NDSEG Fellowships are intended for students at or near the beginning of their graduate studies in science or engineering. The three-year NDSEG Fellowship

Program is open only to applicants who are citizens or nationals of the United States. Proof of citizenship will be required upon formal offer. Persons who hold permanent resident status are not eligible.
