### **Driving Directions:**

### From I-94 (Detroit Metro Airport):

- -- Take US 23 North to Exit 41, Plymouth Road.
- --Follow Plymouth Road West to Huron Parkway, turn Left onto Huron Parkway.
- --Take Huron Parkway (about one mile) to Hubbard Road, turn Right on Hubbard.
- --Follow Hubbard a short distance to a stop sign Hayward Avenue begins at this intersection.
- --As you proceed on Hayward, the FXB Building is two blocks, at the corner of Beal and Hayward, 1320 Beal Avenue.

#### From US 23 (North or South):

- -- Take Exit 41, Plymouth Road.
- --Follow Plymouth Road West to Huron Parkway, turn Left onto Huron Parkway.
- --Take Huron Parkway (about one mile) to Hubbard Road, turn Right on Hubbard.
- --Follow Hubbard a short distance to a stop sign —Hayward Avenue begins at this intersection.
- --As you proceed on Hayward, the FXB Building is two blocks, at the corner of Beal and Hayward, 1320 Beal Avenue.

# **From Plymouth Road:**

- --Follow Plymouth Road West to Huron Parkway, turn Left onto Huron Parkway.
- --Take Huron Parkway (about one mile) to Hubbard Road, turn Right on Hubbard.
- --Follow Hubbard a short distance to a stop sign —Hayward Avenue begins at this intersection.
- --As you proceed on Hayward, the FXB Building is two blocks, at the corner of Beal and Hayward, 1320 Beal Avenue.

# **University of Michigan Permit Parking**

If you have not received a parking permit in advance, please plan to park temporarily across the street from the FXB (on Hayward) in front of the Space Research Building (SRB); there is a pull-off area in front of the SRB. Come up to the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the FXB and request a parking permit from one of our office staff. Your U-M parking permit will allow you to park in any lot indicated with a "P" on the online map: <a href="http://www.umich.edu/~newsinfo/umnc.html">http://www.umich.edu/~newsinfo/umnc.html</a>; please note that some maps may indicate these lots as the color "Blue" -- these are the same lots.

There are generally ample spaces behind the Space Research Building (SRB); the SRB is across the street from Aerospace Engineering on Hayward. The lot in front of GG Brown, also on Hayward, is an alternative. Please reference the map for these locations.

Please hang the parking permit tag on your rear view mirror, with the dates clearly visible through the window. Your vehicle will be ticketed if the permit is not hung, or not properly or clearly displayed.

#### Meter Lots for short-term (1-3 hours) Visitor Parking
